GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS*
FOR TRANSFER STUDENTS WITH A MINIMUM OF 30 SEMESTER HOURS OF
TRANSFER CREDIT**

Effective Fall 2004 Suffolk University will guarantee Northern Essex students admission to the University provided that they have a minimum g.p.a. of 2.5 and have completed the equivalent of 1 ½ years of full-time study at Northern Essex. However, certain programs and applicants have additional requirements required for admission. For example, students interested in transferring to our art and design programs must submit a portfolio. International students must also submit additional documents. Students who do meet these requirements may use the enclosed application for admission. By using this form, it will exempt them from submitting their official high school transcript and the \$50.00 application fee.

Students who have completed less than 1 ½ years will be reviewed on an individual basis for admission. They will need to submit the regular admission application and required credentials.
