Nomination Petition – for election to the Board of Trustees under Chapter 100 (An Act Establishing the Term of Representation of Student Members of the Board of Trustees of Public Colleges and Universities) (21 June 1995) (see over for full text of the law).

Chapter 100 provides for the election of one full-time student annually to the Northern Essex Community College Board of Trustees no later than May fifteenth, the term of office commencing on July 1st and terminating on June 30th. A full-time student is one carrying 12 or more credit hours per semester. All enrolled students may vote.

An election process has been established by the Student Government Associations which included a nomination procedure and a polling period. Twenty student signatures are required in support of a nomination.

ABOUT THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Northern Essex Community College, Haverhill & Lawrence, Massachusetts

Northern Essex Community College is governed by a Board of Trustees, which consists of eleven members. **One member of the Board of trustees is a full-time undergraduate student member**, from the institution, and ten members are appointed by the governor of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Each student member is **elected** by the student body **annually, no later than May fifteenth**. The **term of office** of each elected student member of the board shall be **one year** and shall **commence on July first** following their election and terminate on the June Thirteenth of the following year.

The student member shall be eligible for re-election for as long as the student remains a full-time undergraduate student and **maintain satisfactory academic progress** as determined by the policy of Northern Essex. If at any time during the elected term of office the student member ceases to be a full-time undergraduate student or fails to maintain satisfactory academic progress, the membership of the student on the board shall be terminated and the office of the elected student member shall be deemed vacant.

A vacancy in the office of the elected student member prior to the expiration of a term shall be filled for the remainder of the term in the same manner as student elections to full terms.

No member of a Board of Trustees shall be a member of the Board of Regents of higher education. No member of a Board of Trustees shall be principally employed by any public educational institution or school system, or by the Commonwealth. Membership on a Board of Trustees shall terminate if the Member ceases to be qualified for appointment.
