NEW ENGLAND COLLEGE ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

- 1. New England College agrees to offer admission and Junior Year status to graduates of Northern Essex Community College who have completed the requirements for an Associate's Degree with a cumulative Grade Point Average of at least 2.0, and a minimum of sixty semester hours, and who have not been subject to disciplinary action at Northern Essex Community College.
- 2. Any student who wishes to transfer under the terms of this agreement agrees to complete an official New England College application, and all required application components.
- 3. Northern Essex Community College agrees to provide New England College with accurate and current transcript that includes description of any academic or social disciplinary action taken against the student during his/her enrollment.
- 4. New England college agrees to grant transfer credit for courses taken at Northern Essex Community College in accordance with the TRANSFER CREDIT POLICY STATEMENT and the COURSE EQUIVALENCY STATEMENT contained in this agreement.
- 5. New England College will provide an unofficial transcript evaluation by telephone to Northern Essex Community College students considering matriculation at New England College, and an official transcript evaluation to all applicants within two weeks of receipt of official transcripts from Northern Essex Community College.
- 6. New England College agrees to assign a faculty advisor from the appropriate academic program when a student is accepted, and to notify the student of the advisor's name and telephone number prior to the student's enrollment at New England College.
- 7. Students who are accepted into New England College under the terms of this agreement will be eligible for Financial Aid and on-campus housing under the same conditions and terms as all other entering Junior year students.
- 8. Students who are accepted into New England College will be subject to academic policies and graduation requirements of the College which were in place two years immediately prior to their enrollment.
- 9. This agreement will be reviewed annually. However, each institution agrees to advise the

other of substantive changes in courses or programs as they occur.
