All times listed are understood to be Eastern Daylight Savings (US) unless otherwise noted.

Prices quoted must be available for acceptance for at least ninety (90) days after the closing date.

NECC reserves the right to accept the quote deemed best for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and NECC. The Contract will be awarded to the Vendor who offers the lowest hourly rates as determined by NECC. NECC reserves the right to reject any or all quotes, wholly or in part.

SCOPE OF WORK:

A. GENERAL PARAMETERS: The Work under the Contract consists of:

- Provide labor, material, and equipment to mill 1.5" of the existing parking lot at 78 Amesbury St., Lawrence, MA. Approx. 2,928 sq yards. Repair base as needed. Grade and prepare the area to receive new asphalt to a depth of 1.5" of HOT MIX Asphalt by Machine in one MA DOT State Topcoat. Stripe in accordance with the original layout. Add Small Flower Bed at Building Loam and add Flowers.
- The Contractor will be responsible for securing and paying for any and all necessary licenses, permits, fees, and certificates.

B. INSTALLATION SPECIFICATIONS

- Contractor is responsible to verify all measurements. The parking lot area to be Milled and Repaved is approximately 2,928 sq. yards.
- Coordinate the installation with the Director of Facilities or designee to ensure proper notification to the campus community.
- Ensure all materials are in proper condition prior to installation.
- Contractor should submit a layout of parking lot markings for approval.
- All areas of work should be cleaned up and any material and equipment will need to be out of the way after work is completed for the day.
- Warranty: The Contractor shall provide a minimum one-year warranty for all material and workmanship.

C. ADDITIONAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Project must be completed By October 31, 2022.
- Bidders are encouraged to visit the site and become thoroughly acquainted with all conditions incidental to the completion of all work specified.
- All salvaged material shall be removed from the site after project completion.
- Contractor awarded Contract will be required to sign a Commonwealth of Massachusetts Standard State Contract and Terms and Conditions within ten (10) business days of contract award.

D. PREVAILING WAGE & WEEKLY PAYROLL REPORT

- All work performed under any contract resulting from this RFQ must conform to Massachusetts General Laws, chapter 149 sections 26 and 27 for Prevailing Wage Rates. A copy of the Massachusetts Executive Office of Labor and Workforce Development, Department of Labor Standards (DLS) Prevailing Wage Rates are attached. This schedule shall continue to be the minimum rate of wages for said employees during the life of this Contract including Contract extensions. Labor rates for functions not covered under prevailing wage laws must, at a minimum, meet and include the minimum wage rates established by the DLS. Any questions relative to the applicability of any wage rate shall be directed to the DLS.
- In accordance with Massachusetts General Law c. 149, §27B, a true and accurate record must be kept of all persons employed on the public works project for which the enclosed rates have been provided. A Payroll Form is available from the Department of Labor Standards (DLS) at www.mass.gov/dols/pw and includes all the information required to be kept by law. Every contractor or subcontractor is required to keep these records and preserve them for a period of three years from the date of completion of the contract.

- On a weekly basis, every contractor and subcontractor is required to submit a certified copy of their
 weekly payroll records to the awarding authority; this includes the payroll forms and the Statement of
 Compliance form. The certified payroll records must be submitted either by regular mail or by e-mail
 to the awarding authority. Once collected, the awarding authority is required to preserve those
 records for three years from the date of completion of the project.
- Each such contractor and subcontractor shall furnish weekly and within 15 days after completion of its portion of the work, to the awarding authority directly by first-class mail or e-mail, a statement, executed by the contractor, subcontractor, or by any authorized officer thereof who supervised the payment of wages, this form, accompanied by their payroll.
- Weekly payroll report forms and required statements of compliance are available on the Department of Labor (DLS) website.
- Invoices will be processed once the certified payroll record requirements have been satisfied as required by Mass DLS.

E. WORKFORCE PARTICIPATION

- All contracts by a state agency or state-assisted contracts for design, construction, reconstruction, installation, demolition, maintenance, or repair must contain Workforce Participation Goals for minorities and women as required by M.G.L. c. 149, § 44A(2)(G).
- The Commonwealth of MA has set the following goals for workforce participation for minorities and women. The participation goals for a project shall be 15.3% for minorities and 6.9% for women. The Contractor shall strive to achieve on a project the labor workforce participation goals. Participation goals shall apply in each job category on a project.
- The successful bidder will be required to utilize the revised Weekly Certified Payroll Report form and Statement of Compliance. F. LABOR HARMONY AND OSHA TRAINING CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS

- The undersigned agrees to obtain prior written approval from the Director of Facilities or designee to use sub-bidders. The undersigned further agrees to pay the premiums for the performance and payment bonds furnished by sub-bidders as requested herein and that all of the cost of all such premiums.
- The undersigned agrees that if selected as a general contractor, they will promptly confer with the awarding authority on the question of sub-bidders; and that the awarding authority may substitute for any sub-bid listed above a sub-bid filed with the awarding authority by another sub-bidder for the sub-trade against whose standing and ability the undersigned does not object; and that the undersigned will use all such finally selected sub-bidders at the amounts named in their respective sub-bids and be in every way as responsible for them and their work as if they had been originally named in this general bid, the total contract price being adjusted to conform thereto.
- The undersigned agrees that, if selected as a general contractor, we will within ten days, Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays excluded, after presentation thereof by the awarding authority, execute a contract in accordance with the terms of this bid and furnish a performance bond and also a labor and materials or payment bond, each of a surety company qualified to do business under the laws of the Commonwealth and satisfactory to the awarding authority and each in the sum of the contract price, the premiums for which are to be paid by the general contractor and are included in the contract price.
- The undersigned hereby certifies that he is able to furnish labor that can work in harmony with all other elements of labor employed or to be employed on the work; that all employees to be employed

at the worksite will have successfully completed a course in construction safety and health approved by the United States Occupational Safety and Health Administration that is at least 10 hours in duration at the time the employee begins work and who shall furnish documentation of successful completion of the said course with the first certified payroll report for each employee; and that he will comply fully with all laws and regulations applicable to awards made subject to section 44A.

- The undersigned further certifies under the penalties of perjury that this bid is in all respects bona fide, fair, and made without collusion or fraud with any other person. As used in this subsection the word "person" shall mean natural person, joint venture, partnership, corporation, or other business or legal entity. The undersigned further certifies under penalty of perjury that the said undersigned is not presently debarred from doing public construction work in the Commonwealth under the provisions of section twenty-nine F of chapter twenty-nine, or any other applicable debarment provisions of any other chapter of the General Laws or any rule or regulation promulgated thereunder.
- The Contractor shall provide a written copy of the Companies Safety program. The safety program shall meet all Federal, State, and Local regulations including the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 (OSHA). All of the Contractor's service and installation employees shall have a certificate outlining they have attended a safety program through a certified safety training program or agency. Contractor shall comply with all OSHA enforcement procedures for occupational exposure to bloodborne pathogens. All employees must have received minimum federal training on blood-borne pathogens, handling of hazardous materials, and instruction in the right-to-know laws and are fully able to understand Safety Data Sheets and other published notices before being allowed to work on NECC property. Training procedures, records, and documentation of instructor qualifications or certification shall be submitted to NECC.

G. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

The Contractor shall purchase and maintain at its sole cost and expense throughout the term of this Contract adequate insurance coverage necessary for the performance of the work under the Contract. Such insurance should include but not be limited to the following types and amounts of coverage:

Workmen's Compensation Insurance is in compliance with applicable federal and state laws, including Employers Liability Insurance with limits of at least one million dollars (\$1,000.000) per occurrence.

Automobile Liability Insurance covers owned, non-owned, and hired vehicles with combined limits for bodily injury and property damage of at least one million (\$1,000,000) per accident. The policy must be endorsed to include the College as an additional insured.

Commercial General Liability Insurance including products and completed operations liability, and contractual liability coverage specifically covering this Agreement, written on an occurrence form, with combined limits for bodily injury, personal injury, and property damage of at least one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence and three million (\$3,000,000) per aggregate. This policy must be endorsed to include the College as an additional insured.

Each certificate or instrument shall contain a valid provision of endorsement that the policy may not be canceled, terminated, changed, or modified without giving thirty (30) days written notice thereof to the College and that the insurance company waives their right to subrogation and indemnification against the College and the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

All insurance policies required herein shall contain the following provision or its equivalent with the same meaning and intent:

"The insurance company waives any right of subrogation and indemnification against Northern Essex Community College, its trustees, officers, employees or their agents, or the Commonwealth of Massachusetts which may arise by reason of any payments under this policy".

H. PAYMENT BOND

• A 50% Payment Bond will be required over \$25,000. The Contractor has ten business days from the date of notification of the contract award to obtain the payment bond.

I. INSPECTION

• NECC has the right to inspect all materials and products before and during installation, and at the completion of the project.

J. TIME OF COMPLETION

• All work must be completed on or before October 31, 2022.

K. COORDINATION

- The Contractor shall submit for approval to the Director of Facilities or designee a detailed operational plan and construction schedule showing the sequence of operations prior to commencement of any work at the site. NECC must approve any changes to the accepted operational plan and construction schedule. NECC shall assist the Contractor to perform the work in accordance with the approved operational plan by removing obstructions that may be in the Contractor's way, upon proper notice from the Contractor.
- The Contractor must retain a competent full-time superintendent, satisfactory to NECC who shall be on-site during all work in progress. This representative shall not be changed, except with the consent of NECC. The representative shall be in full charge of the work and all instructions given to this person by NECC shall be binding.
- The Contractor must supply to NECC the telephone number of a responsible person who may be contacted during non-work-hours for emergencies on the Project.

Information about Prevailing Wage Schedules for Awarding Authorities and Contractors

- The wage rates will remain in effect for the duration of the project, except in the case of multi-year public construction projects. For construction projects lasting longer than one year, awarding authorities must request an updated wage schedule no later than two weeks before the anniversary of the date the contract was executed by the awarding authority and the general contractor. For multi-year CM AT RISK projects, the awarding authority must request an annual update no later than two weeks before the anniversary date, determined as the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the execution date of the first amendment to permit procurement of construction services. The annual update requirement is not applicable to 27F "rental of equipment" contracts. The updated wage schedule must be provided to all contractors, including general and sub-contractors, working on the construction project.
- This wage schedule applies only to the specific project referenced at the top of this page and uniquely identified by the "Wage Request Number" on all pages of this schedule.
- An Awarding Authority must request an updated wage schedule if it has not opened bids or selected a contractor within 90 days of the date of issuance of the wage schedule. For CM AT RISK projects (bid pursuant to G.L. c.149A), the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the bid for the first construction scope of work must be within 90-days of the wage schedule issuance date.
- The wage schedule shall be incorporated in any advertisement or call for bids for the project as required by M.G.L. c. 149, § 27. The wage schedule shall be made a part of the contract awarded for the project. The wage schedule must be posted in a conspicuous place at the work site for the life of the project in accordance with M.G.L. c. 149 § 27. The wages listed on the wage schedule must be paid to employees performing construction work on the project whether they are employed by the prime contractor, a filed sub-bidder, or a sub-contractor.
- Apprentices working on the project are required to be registered with the Massachusetts Division of Apprentice Standards (DAS).
 Apprentices must keep their apprentice identification card on their persons during all work hours on the project. An apprentice registered with DAS may be paid the lower apprentice wage rate at the applicable step as provided on the prevailing wage schedule. Any apprentice not registered with DAS regardless of whether they are registered with another federal, state, local, or private agency must be paid the journeyworker's rate.
- Every contractor or subcontractor working on the construction project must submit weekly payroll reports and a Statement of Compliance directly to the awarding authority by mail or email and keep them on file for three years. Each weekly payroll report must contain: the employee's name, address, occupational classification, hours worked, and wages paid. Do not submit weekly payroll reports to DLS. For a sample payroll reporting form go to http://www.mass.gov/dols/pw.
- Contractors with questions about the wage rates or classifications included on the wage schedule have an affirmative obligation to inquire with DLS at (617) 626-6953.
- Contractors must obtain the wage schedules from awarding authorities. Failure of a contractor or subcontractor to pay the prevailing wage rates listed on the wage schedule to all employees who perform construction work on the project is a violation of the law and subjects the contractor or subcontractor to civil and criminal penalties.
- Employees not receiving the prevailing wage rate set forth on the wage schedule may file a complaint with the Fair Labor Division of the office of the Attorney General at (617) 727-3465.
